### General Instructions

- Papers and posters should be related to Pediatrics.
- Presenting author should be a registered delegate of the conference.
- At least one of the authors should be a member of IAP Delhi.
- Write Title, Category (Award/Free/Poster), name of authors and institution with city on first page. Provide name, email and mobile phone number of the presenting author. Do not include degrees or professional designations. Quote the IAP membership number of at least one of the authors. For award papers, mention the age of presenting author.
- Time for oral presentation is 8 minutes followed by 3 minutes for questions asked by panel of judges.
- No Delegate can present more than one paper in one category.
- Last date for submission is 15th August, 2023.

### Free Paper Category

- Papers not chosen for awards will be considered for free paper/ poster presentation.
- Free Papers may be submitted directly also.
- Only Abstract need to be submitted.
- Abstract should be printed using ARIAL font, with font size 12 and should not be more than 250 words.

### Physical Poster

- One Soft Copy should be submitted for Poster Presentation.
- Use tables or figures appropriately.

### Thesis

- Soft copy of complete thesis should be mailed at **abstractspcni@gmail.com**
- A separate one page should be submitted in same mail with the Identification detail of the student & institution.
- The remaining Thesis document should be completely blinded
- Thesis Completed and submitted in 2022 & 2023 would only be accepted.
- Undertaking has to be submitted that the submitted study has not be presented in other conferences/CME and not published till date.

### **AWARD RULES**

- 1. It is open to a Regular Member of the Academy IAP Delhi.
- 2. Contestants should not be of more than 35 years of age as on 17<sup>th</sup> Sept 2023.
- 3. Dr P N Taneja Award, Dr Satya Gupta Award & Dr Sarla Vaishnava Award, Only that work shall be allowed to be presented, which the candidate has done in one of the Institution based in Union Territory of Delhi.
- 4. For all other Awards work from anywhere in India is allowed.
- 5. In case the candidate is working in any of the institution, the paper should be accompanied by a certificate from the Head of the Dept./Institution that the work has been conducted by the candidate & that it has not been presented or published elsewhere earlier.
- 6. All the papers submitted will be judged by a Committee of Experts and 75% marks allotted. Up to 4 papers will be selected from each category and presented, where a panel of judges will judge the papers only on presentation. 25% marks will be allotted and for awarding the best paper in a given category, the total of both marks shall be considered.
- 7. Papers should be ethically acceptable.
- 8. Only One Award will be given in each Award. The value of each Award is
