





Sir/Madam,

National Commission for Protection of Child Rights (NCPCR) is a statutory body constituted under section (3) of the Commission for Protection of Child Rights (CPCR) Act, 2005 to protect the child rights and other related matters in the country. The Commission is further mandated to monitor the proper and effective implementation of Protection of children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act, 2012; Juvenile Justice (Care & Protection of Children) Act, 2015 and Right to Free and Compulsory Education (RTE) Act, 2009.

2. Obesity has become a major public health concern, affecting populations worldwide, including India, where cases have risen sharply in recent decades. It is a condition characterized by excessive fat accumulation that poses significant risks to physical health, leading to serious non-communicable diseases (NCDs) such as diabetes, hypertension, cardiovascular diseases, and certain cancers. The increasing prevalence of obesity is driven by multiple factors, including unhealthy dietary habits, sedentary lifestyles, urbanization, and reduced physical activity. A recent Lancet study projects that by 2050, nearly 449 million Indians—almost one-third of the population—will be overweight or obese, highlighting the urgent need for intervention.

3. Obesity in children not only leads to long-term health complications such as diabetes, hypertension, and cardiovascular diseases but also affects their emotional and social development. Recognizing the urgency of this issue, the National Commission for Protection of Child Rights (NCPCR) is organizing a **Consultative Meeting on Childhood Obesity** to bring together key experts, policymakers, educators, and health professionals to discuss strategies for prevention, intervention, and long-term policy solutions.

4. The objective of this meeting is to deliberate on the alarming rise in childhood obesity and develop a comprehensive, multi-sectoral approach to address this crisis. The discussions will focus on understanding the current scenario, examining the health and psychological impact of obesity, evaluating the role of schools and communities in promoting healthy lifestyles, and exploring policy measures to regulate food choices and lifestyle habits. Through this initiative, we aim to formulate actionable recommendations that will contribute to creating a healthier environment for children and ensuring their right to a balanced and nutritious life.

5. In view of above, I take this opportunity to invite you to kindly be a part of the meeting and share your valuable inputs and knowledge. The meeting has been scheduled for **13th May, 2025, at 15:30hrs at Conference Hall, 2nd floor, NCPCR Office, Chanderlok Building, 36 Janpath, New Delhi.** In case of unavailability, you're kindly requested to nominate concerned senior level official for attending the meeting.
