





Conducted successfully a dedicated **Critical Care Nephrology Workshop** as part of **North Zone Pedicon & PCNI 2025** on Sunday, **24th August 2025 at Batra Hospital, New Delhi**. The workshop witnessed the enthusiastic **Participation of 40 Delegates** and Faculty members, bringing together pediatricians and nephrology experts to enhance clinical understanding and practical skills in the management of critically ill children with renal complications. The academic session on Approach to Dysnatremias, Acute Kidney Injury-Lessons Learnt in the Last Decade, Rapidly Progressive Glomerulonephritis and Extracorporeal Therapies in the ICU featured four in-depth lectures, **Each of 40 minutes**, delivered by renowned experts in the field. These lectures provided valuable insights into current practices, evolving evidence, and clinical challenges in pediatric nephrology critical care. Conducted a Successful Workshop on **Daily Pediatrics Practice Potpourri: Understanding the Common Evaluations** held at **Hamdard Institute of Medical Sciences & Research (HIMSR)** on **Friday 29th August**, as a part of the **North Zone Pedicon & PCNI 2025**. The Objectives of the workshop are to improve the understanding and interpretation of some key routine evaluations, Target Audience: PGs and Senior Residents and Young (age or attitude) Pediatricians wanting a knowledge upgrade by the renewed faculty in the field. The Sessions covered Understanding Anthropometry, use of growth charts, monitor growth of preterm /SGA, which charts to use, Malnutrition, Short stature, Bone age assessment, Nuances in Development assessment, RED FLAGS and Poor scholastic performance. Automated CBC – why do we need beyond the basic few parameters? What is the purpose and interpretation of these Parameters which a CBC automated report provides, Learning through Case studies /examples. Blood chemistries-what do they signify: KFT: Identifying AKI, Recognizing CKD: LFT: Interpreting bilirubin patterns, transaminitis, hepatic synthetic dysfunction Urine analysis-sugar, albumin, cells and beyond. Conventional Respiratory Imaging: Upper Resp tract, Chest radiograph, Basics of Pediatric EKG and Basics of PFT (Spirometry and FOT). Total 40 participants attended the workshop. The workshop was well-received with active Participation and positive feedback. Attendees appreciated the practical, case-based approach and the clarity in explaining often overlooked but essential evaluation tools in Pediatric practice. The event successfully bridged knowledge gaps and contributed to the professional development of young Pediatricians.


