The **Scientific Papers** selected for various **Awards 2026** will be presented at the Pediatric Conference of North India (PCNI 2026), scheduled to be held on 20–21 June 2026 at Hotel Le Meridien, New Delhi.

Residents and Eligible Members fulfilling the criteria laid down in the “**Awards Rules**” are invited to submit their papers for the following awards:

1. Best Thesis Award for PG (MD/DNB) Pediatrics
2. Best Super-Speciality Thesis Award for (DM/DrNB/FNB) Pediatrics Super-Speciality
3. Paper Presentation Awards
Oral Presentation Award (Research only)
Physical Poster Presentation Award (Case Report/Research)
4. Special Award for Best Physical Poster by UG (MBBS) Student
5. Young Pediatricians Award for Original Research conducted after MD by an IAP member aged 40 years or Younger (Original Research only; no case reports/case series)
6. Public Awareness Poster by Subspecialty Chapter
7. Case Cafes
8. Radiological Cases
9. QI Projects with Outcomes

Guidelines for Scientific Paper & Poster Presentation: Papers should be submitted typed in double spacing, on a single side, according to the Instructions given as per Indian Pediatrics. Each submission must be accompanied by a certificate from the Head of the Department stating that:

- The work has been conducted by the candidate, and
- The work has not been published elsewhere earlier.

Last date for submission of papers: 30th April 2026

We encourage all eligible members to actively participate & showcase their academic work at PCNI 2026.

Guidelines for Scientific Paper & Poster Presentation

General Instructions

- The paper or poster must be related to Pediatrics.
- The presenting author must be a registered delegate of the conference.
- At least one of the authors must be a member of IAP.
- On the first page, mention the Title, Category (Award/Free/Poster), names of authors & institution with city.
 - Provide the name, email ID, and mobile number of the presenting author.
 - Do not include degrees or professional designations.
 - Mention the IAP membership number of at least one author.
 - For Award papers, mention the age of the presenting author.
- *Time allotted for Oral Presentation: 8 minutes, followed by 3 mins for questions by the panel of judges.*
- *A delegate cannot present more than one paper in the same category.*
- *Conference updates will be regularly displayed on the website: www.iapdelhi.org*
- *Full paper must be submitted; abstracts alone will not be accepted.*
- *Papers should be prepared in "Indian Pediatrics" Original Article format.*
- *One soft copy should be sent to: abstractspcni@gmail.com*
- *Last date of submission: 30th April 2026*

Free Paper Category:

- Papers will be considered for Free Paper / Poster Presentation.
- Free papers may also be submitted directly under this category.
- The abstract should be typed in ARIAL font, size 12, and should not exceed 250 words.

Thesis Category:

- A soft copy of the complete thesis should be emailed to: abstractspcni@gmail.com
- A separate one-page document containing identification details of the student and institution must be submitted in the same email.
- The remaining thesis document should be blinded.
- Only completed and submitted theses will be accepted.
- An undertaking must be submitted stating that the study has not been presented at any other conference/CME and has not been published to date.

Guidelines for Scientific Paper

1. The awards are open to **Regular Members of the Indian Academy of Pediatrics (IAP)**.
2. Contestants **should not be more than 35 years** of age as on 31st December of the concerned year.
3. If the **candidate is working in an institution**, the **paper must be accompanied** by a **certificate from the Head of the Department/Institution** stating that the work has been conducted by candidate.
4. All papers will be judged by a **Committee of Experts**, with **60% marks allotted for the manuscript**. Selected papers from each category will be presented at the conference, where a panel of judges will award 40% marks for presentation. The final award in each category will be decided based on the total of both scores.
5. **Papers must be ethically acceptable.**
6. **Only one award will be given in each category.** The details are as follows:

Award Rules

7. Papers should be submitted, typed in double spacing, single side, and prepared according to the "Instructions for Authors" in Indian Pediatrics. Authors are advised to check the latest guidelines at www.indianpediatrics.net before submission.
8. The **identity of the Authors and the Institution/place of work** must not be disclosed in the full paper. These details should appear only on the Title Page (first page) and in the covering letter attached with the submission.
9. A **minimum of 50% of pre-judgment marks** must be obtained to qualify for presentation at the conference.
10. Time allotted for **each paper presentation shall be 10 minutes for presentation and 5 minutes for discussion.**
11. For a paper to be considered for an award, the candidate must present the paper personally.
12. The **decision of the Judges and the Executive Committee shall be final and binding.** No correspondence in this regard will be entertained.
13. **Papers must be submitted on or before 30th April 2026.**
